

Statement of Compliance with the European Union Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS-2):

1. Background

This statement is based on the EU-Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS-2):

DIRECTIVE 2011/65/EU of the EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT and of The COUNCIL of 8 June 2011 on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (recast)

Plus

Commission Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 dated 31 March 2015 amending Annex II to Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the list of restricted substances

Updated list of maximum concentration values (MCV):

Lead: 0.1% = 1000 ppm

Cadmium 0.01% = 100 ppm

Mercury 0.1% = 1000 ppm

Hexavalent chromium VI 0.1% = 1000 ppm

PBB 0.1% = 1000 ppm

PBDE 0.1% = 1000 ppm

Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP): 0.1%= 1000 ppm

Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP): 0.1%= 1000 ppm

Dibutyl phthalate (DBP): 0.1%= 1000 ppm

Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP): 0.1%= 1000 ppm

2. Scope

This statement relates to all products purchased, manufactured and sold by G. Beres Marketing under various brand names (hereinafter "GB Products").

3. Compliance statement

None of the hazardous substances listed above are intentionally added to GB Products during the manufacturing process.


The concentrations of the hazardous substances listed above found in the components and raw materials used to manufacture GB Products are well below the MCV allowed.
